

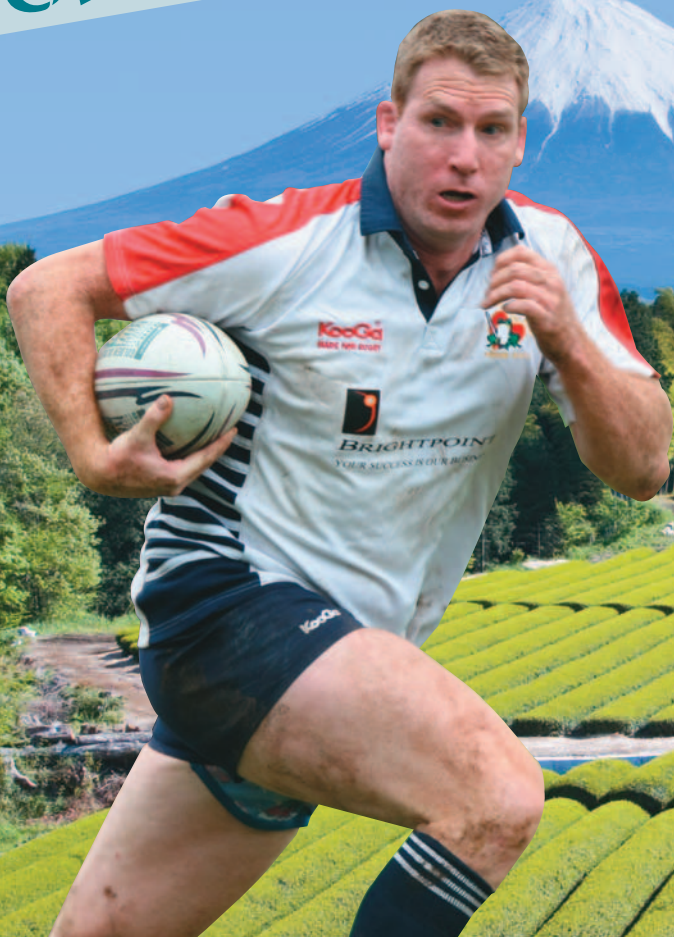

The Rugby

Golden Oldies Rugby is part of the Golden Oldies family of Sporting Festivals which have been held throughout the world since 1979. The first Golden Oldies World Rugby Festival was held in Auckland, New Zealand in 1979.

Since then Festivals have been held in the USA, England, Canada, Ireland, South Africa, France, Scotland and Japan in 2012.

Fukuoka has 15 grounds available to host the Rugby matches on, including the home grounds of the Coca Cola Red Sparks professional Rugby team. All fields are within a 30 minute coach ride from the centre of Fukuoka city, and of course there will be a central gathering point to enjoy the after match festivities that have become synonymous with the Golden Oldies World Rugby Festival.

What's in a name?

The name 'Golden Oldies' does not mean your team cannot play Rugby to the best of its ability or to your teams strengths. The teams that you are drawn against will reflect the level of play which you have told us your team prefers, ranging from competitive to social and anywhere in between.

The difference is we don't publish the scores and there is no overall Festival winner. It's a Festival of Rugby. Age is no barrier except you have to have reached the age of 35 years young to participate.



RUGBY PACKAGES

Nothing is left to chance

With Golden Oldies Festivals nothing is left to chance. The Rugby, transport, accommodation and social functions are all planned and co-ordinated for you and your team. In Fukuoka we can also ensure the hospitality and enthusiasm of the local Rugby fraternity.

The visitors Festival package will include:

- Parade of Nations and Opening Ceremony.
- Team Managers briefing meeting.
- Three days of Rugby.
- Seven nights accommodation. Your team chooses the level and category of accommodation it wants. (Breakfast is included)
- One team transfer to/from your hotel upon your Fukuoka arrival and departure.
- Air-conditioned coach transfers between your hotel and the Rugby grounds on each games day.
- Air-conditioned coach transfers to and from the official social functions.
- Three traditional social functions including meals and drinks:
 - Welcome Party - three hour function inclusive of substantial finger buffet, beer, wine, soft drinks and entertainment.
 - The Golden Oldies Rugby Festival Picnic Day - lunch, beer, wine, soft drinks and entertainment.
 - Grand Finale Dinner and Air New Zealand Awards - five hour function inclusive of three course meal, beer, wine, soft drinks and entertainment.
- Hospitality and information desks at selected hotels.
- Festival souvenir.
- Personality of the Day medallions (one each day, per team).
- Four editions of the 'Late Tackle' Festival Newspaper.
- Liaison Officers to assist Team Managers.

Your entry guide

Entries: All teams must enter on the official entry form attached, and be accompanied by a non refundable team entry fee of JPY18,000. The team entry fee can be paid by credit card (Visa or Mastercard) or be transferred directly to the bank account included on the official entry form. Please note the team entry fee is in addition to the Festival Package purchased and you will be advised of the payment schedule and cancellation fees associated with the Festival Package at the time of entry.

Teams / Players: You can enter more than one team if you have sufficient players. The entry fee will apply to each team entry.

Individuals: Individual entrants are also welcome to enter and be allocated to a pool team. Please contact the Golden Oldies World Rugby Secretariat for further details.

The organisation

The games at these Festivals are especially for players aged 35 years and over. They provide fun for all players and focus on participation rather than winning. The whole Festival ensures enjoyment and new experiences for players, partners and supporters.

The worldwide Golden Oldies Movement is co-ordinated in New Zealand by the Golden Oldies World Secretariat under the auspices of Air New Zealand. Guidelines in the form of a Team Managers manual, brochures, newsletters and DVD's will be available.

Conditions of entry

Completing the entry form and paying the entry fee means that you are deemed to have accepted the following conditions:

1. The 19th Air New Zealand Golden Oldies World Rugby Festival (the 2012 Festival) is an invitation event and the Golden Oldies World Secretariat (World Secretariat) will only accept entries on this basis.
2. All players must be 35 years or older on 28 October 2012.
3. All teams travelling by air are required to travel on Air New Zealand Limited's services or other approved Star Alliance or partner carrier(s). Details will be provided as entries are received.
4. All teams must complete a form listing all team members' names and addresses (whether players or supporters) once the entry has been accepted.
5. All entries will be subject to acceptance by the Golden Oldies World Secretariat which reserves the right to decline or withdraw any entry at any time should it consider there is non-compliance with the Conditions of Entry. If a team is so rejected, any refund of ground package payments will only be made in accordance with the event payment schedule and refund rules applying to all teams.
6. The Golden Oldies World Secretariat reserves the right to determine the maximum number of entries from any one country.
7. Entries will close on 30 August 2012 or at any other time at the discretion of the Golden Oldies World Secretariat.
8. Entries will be accepted from clubs, groups or individuals who wish to form a Golden Oldies team.
9. Participants normally resident in Fukuoka may purchase a local package. Other teams must purchase an accommodation package.
10. Residential addresses of local team members must be supplied if requested by the Golden Oldies World Secretariat.
11. All teams must complete the official entry form, in this brochure and their appointed representative sign the Waiver, Release and Indemnification below.
12. Air New Zealand Limited reserves the right to change any venue of the 2012 Festival or any part thereof, including its removal to another country if it determines such a measure is necessary by reason of changes circumstances or conditions existing or anticipated at the 2012 Festival venue.
13. The Golden Oldies World Secretariat collects participants personal information in order to conduct the event. If the information requested is not provided the participant may not participate in the event. Please refer to Air New Zealand Limited's Privacy Policy at www.airnz.co.nz/privacy_policy.htm regarding the storage of personal information.
14. All players will be required to sign a waiver before the first round of games in Fukuoka.

Air New Zealand Limited acts only as agents for the providers of ground services included in this package and will not be liable for any injury, cost damage, expense, loss or delay which may be sustained or occasioned by reason of the negligence or default of any person or sub-contractor engaged to provide such services.

Unforeseen circumstances may necessitate the lengthening or shortening of the Festival and in such cases adjustment to the cost of the package will be on a pro-rata basis.

No refund will be made if any portion of the 2012 Festival package is unused by the participant.

The passenger ticket when issued by the airline concerned shall constitute the sole contract between the Carrier concerned and the passenger and carriage by air will be subject to the actual carrier's Conditions of Carriage.
