LUGGAGE

Guests are currently travelling with hard pack suitcases and way too much luggage. This leads to discomfort for all of the guests on tour as the suitcases do not fit into the lockers. Suitcases prevent access to the freezer, they block access to lockers, they cause unnecessary congestion at the entrance to the truck and they could become a hazard in the truck if the driver has to apply brakes.

DAY 1 - SOUTH AFRICA - CEDERBERG MOUNTAIN REGION

Leaving Cape Town we make our first stop at Table View and take photos of Table Mountain from across Table Bay. We will be heading north towards our stop for the first night, passing through the Cederberg Region. Upon arrival at our overnight stop, we will enjoy a wine tasting, sampling wines from the region. Tonight we will be treated to a traditional South African meal, followed by a full tour briefing from your guides. Meals: L Included Highlight: Wine tasting - Piketberg local wine farm

DAY 2 - NAMIBIA - GARIEP (ORANGE) RIVER

After an early start, we continue north via the distant town of Springbok, best known for its diamonds, copper and spring flowers. We then proceed to our camp located right beside the Namibian border. The camp is situated on the riverbank that forms the border between South Africa and Namibia, Meals: B.L.D

DAY 3 GARIEP (ORANGE) RIVER - FISH RIVER CANYON

This morning theres the chance to see the beautiful river valley by canoe or just relax at camp. After lunch we cross the border and travel to the Fish River Canyon. We enjoy a scenic walk along the edge of the canyon before enjoying our dinner, while watching the sunset. This is also a fantastic photo opportunity. Meals: B,L,D Included Highlight: Scenic walk along the rim of Fish River Canyon

DAY 4 - NAMIB - NAUKLUFT PARK

We arrive at the Namib-Naukluft National Park and set up camp, then enjoy a short hike into the Sesriem Canyon. Tonight we enjoy the star-studded sky and enduring silence of the Namib Desert, only occasionally interrupted by the call of a jackal or, a rather unique lizard, the barking gecko! Meals: B,L,D

DAY 5 - SOSSUSVLEI DUNES - NAMIB - NAUKLUFT NATIONAL PARK

This is our earliest morning as we prepare for our hike up Dune 45 to marvel at the sunrise. After our hike, we will have the chance to visit Sossusvlei. Later we join a local expert on a guided hike and learn more about the unique desert ecosystem and how the Bushmen survived in the harsh desert conditions. Meals: B,L,D Included Highlights: Hike up Dune 45, walk into Sesriem Canyon

DAY 6/7 - SWAKOPMUND

After a brief photo stop while crossing the Tropic of Capricorn, we travel onto Namibia's Atlantic coast and the adventure capital, Swakopmund. Just before we arrive in Swakopmund, we stop at the Walvis Bay lagoon en-route, where there are often flamingos to be seen. You will be briefed on the many optional activities available here and there is time to explore the town before dinner out at one of the local restaurants. Day 7: Today is your chance to experience the adrenalin filled atmosphere that Swakopmund offers. Taking a walk around Swakopmunds shops and having a leisurely lunch is also a great way to spend your day if you are not participating in the many activities available on offer here. Meals: B, L

DAY 8 - SPITZKOPPE

Leaving the coast we drive through arid landscapes to Spitzkoppe Mountain. The enormous granite monoliths dominate the otherwise flat landscape and we set up camp in the wild plain at the base of the mountain. This afternoon our guide will take us on a guided walk to explore the unique rock formations. The more



adventurous among us may want to try some mountain climbing for some stunning views of the landscape. Meals: B,L,D

DAY 9 - HIMBA TRIBES: OUTJO

We visit a Himba community close to Kamanjab where you will have an opportunity to interact with the people who live there. This is a working village and is only a representation of a larger group of nomadic pastoralists. The semi-nomadic Himba people are extremely susceptible to Western influence and have lost a large portion of their land to farmers, engineers, miners and many were displaced during the wars that raged in Angola. The dwindling number of pastoralists that still exist in their natural environment are protected as far as possible. Tourists who would like to get a better understanding of the way of the Himba, their lifestyle and their traditions, can do so without interfering with those still living in their natural environment. Visiting the Himba tribe can be a controversial topic that gets discussed at the camp fire, however not so much if the reason for visiting this particular tribe is understood beforehand. The income that this specific tribe generates from the visits goes towards the education of orphaned Himba children and assists the tribe in giving them a chance to learn about their own culture and heritage. There is a market at the end of your visit, this is a way for the women to establish a small income, used for their own private expenses, and it is up to you whether you'd like to purchase anything or not. Meals: B,L,D Activity package: Guided visit to the Himba tribe

DAY 10 - ETOSHA NATIONAL PARK

Etosha is the venue for some of the most unique game viewing experiences in Africa. The sparse grasslands allow great opportunities to see animals normally hidden in dense vegetation. You may even see some of the amazing animals crossing the road in front of your truck! We will go on various game drives and spend our evenings at the abundant waterholes for some excellent game photography. Meals: B,L,D Included Highlight: Full day game drive in Nomad truck

DAY 11 - ETOSHA NATIONAL PARK

Leaving the city sights behind us, we travel into Namibia's barren northern area. On the way we stop at a popular craft market where you can barter for handmade gifts to take home. We enter Etosha National Park and game drive through to our campsite for the night. Meals: B,L,D Included Highlight: Craft market stop en-route, Entrance to Etosha National Park, Afternoon game drive in Nomad truck

DAY 12 - WINDHOEK

After an early morning game drive we set off towards Windhoek, the Capital city of Namibia. On the way we stop at a popular craft market where you can barter for handmade gifts to take home. Windhoek is not only the capital; it is also the cultural, social and economic centre of Namibia. On arrival in Windhoek our guide will take us on a short drive through Windhoek in our truck. Joes Beer House is an exciting dining experience for our optional dinner out. Meals: B,L Included Highlight: Drive through Windhoek with the Nomad truck

DAY 13 - BOTSWANA - GHANZI

After an early start, we say goodbye to Namibia and cross the Botswana border. Later we arrive at our lodge in Ghanzi and this evening we experience some traditional tribal dancing from the local San community. Meals: B,L,D Included Highlight: Bushman Tribal dance in evening

DAY 14 - GATEWAY TO THE OKAVANGO DELTA

This morning you will have the opportunity to participate in an optional bushman walk with the locals, before we continue our journey north towards Etsha and venture into the bush. We spend the night at our overnight camp on the banks of a beautiful lagoon. Please note: If you have not purchased the Activity Package you will stay at this campsite for the 2 nights that the rest of the group travel into the Okavango Delta. Meals: B,L,D



DAY 15 - OKAVANGO DELTA

After a leisurely breakfast we depart on our boat cruise to Seronga via the winding channels of the Delta. A vehicle transfer sees us arrive at our base for the next two nights, where we settle in and prepare for our afternoon mokoro trip that ends with sundowners overlooking the waterways of the Delta. The evening is spent around the campfire. Note: Activities may vary depending on water levels. Meals: B,L,D

DAY 16 - OKAVANGO DELTA

An early start sees us head off on the crystal clear waters of the Okavango. Water lily beds and palm islands make for the most scenic of experiences. We stop at an island for a nature walk, where we have the possibility of seeing wildlife. We return to camp to relax before heading out onto the water for a sunset cruise. Meals: B,L,D

DAY 17 - OKAVANGO DELTA - CAPRIVI REGION

Today we bid farewell to the Delta and head north. After being re-united with our truck, we re-enter Namibia. Our overnight is located on the banks of the Okavango River in the Caprivi Strip of north-eastern Namibia. Meals: B,L,D

DAY 18 - KASANE - CHOBE NATIONAL PARK

This morning we travel through the Caprivi Strip and onto Kasane. This afternoon we will enjoy a sunset boat cruise on the Chobe River.

DAY 19 - ZIMBABWE - VICTORIA FALLS

Established in 1968, the Chobe National Park covers approximately 11700 sq kms, encompassing floodplains, swamps and woodland. We will rise early to enjoy a game drive through the park, in search of vast herd of elephants and a multitude of antelope including the rare sable. After our game drive, we will pack our bags and head to Victoria Falls. Meals: B,L

DAY 20 -

Most people will spend the day White Water Rafting, a not-to-be-missed experience of a lifetime! Vic Falls offers many exciting activities and today you will have the day free to participate in the activities on offer. Meals: B

DAY 21 - LUSAKA

Leaving behind the natural wonder of Victoria Falls we begin our expedition. After Livingstone we journey towards the bustling Zambian capital of Lusaka. You will notice the vegetation becoming sub-tropical and the roads a little rougher. Meals: L,D

DAY 22 - PETAUKE

Today is a long drive through lush country, crossing rivers en-route to Petauke, the gateway to the South Luangwa NP. Zambia is truly African and an adjustment from the more Western ways of Southern Africa. Meals: B,L,D

DAY 23 - SOUTH LUANGWA NATIONAL PARK

Early in the morning we drive from Petauke to the border of the South Luangwa National Park where we will spend the next two nights right on the banks of the Luangwa River. Before our arrival at the South Luangwa NP, we will stop at the community run tribal textile project. The Tribal textile production factory is closed annually from December to March, when we will not be able to view the fabric production, however the textile shop is open all year round. This afternoon we enjoy a sunset game drive in the South Luangwa NP (the game drive may take place the following day due to time constraints). Meals: B,L,D Included Highlight: Textile Project Visit in South Luangwa

DAY 24 - SOUTH LUANGWA NATIONAL PARK

In the morning you will have the opportunity to take an optional game drive through the South Luangwa National Park, which is known for its high concentration of leopards and hippos. You can often see hippos and other animals from the camp bar. Meals:



B,L,D Note: The Tribal textile production factory is closed annually from December to March, we will therefore not be able to view the fabric production, however the textile shop is open all year round.

DAY 25 - LAKE MALAWI - MALAWI

Today we depart the South Luangwa NP and head towards Lake Malawi. Ngala Beach lies on the shore of Lake Malawi and is a town of considerable historical note.
