# Centennial Parklands is Rugby Central

Covering more than 360 hectares, the Parklands is one of the world's finest and most used urban spaces. Less than 5 km from Sydney's Central Business District, Rugby Central is just a short bus trip from the Festival accommodation. There will be over 30 Rugby Fields in the one location for the Festival, varying from open playing fields to grounds encircled by picket fences. All grounds are used for Rugby matches and are regularly maintained. A central hospitality marquee with seating for up to 1200 will be created within the Parklands to provide food and beverage services and an entertainment area where players can cool down. Showers, toilets and changing room facilities will be adjacent to the marquee, as well as Festival merchandising and an information area.

## food and wine

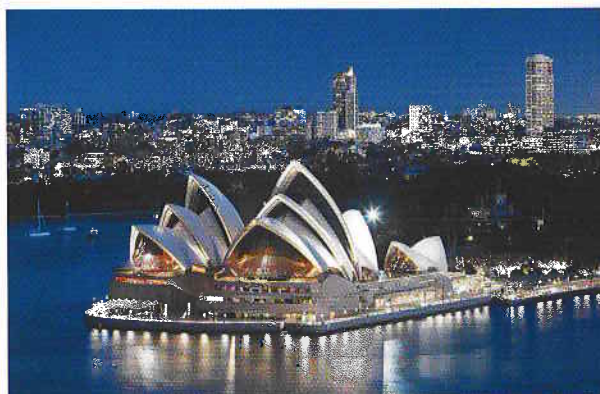

The visitors' Festival package will include:

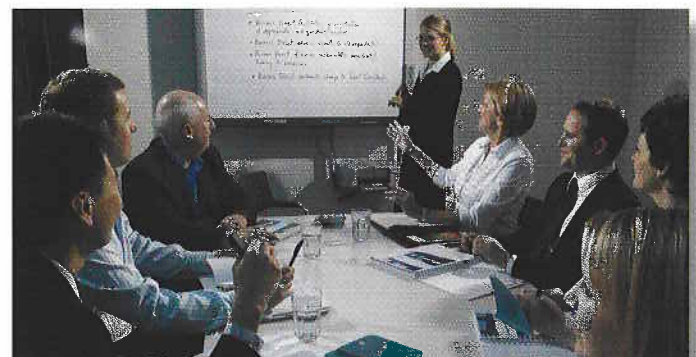

**Entries:** Team entries must be on the official entry form attached to this brochure and accompanied by the entry fee of AU\$300.00 payable to the '2010 Golden Oldies Rugby World Festival'. The entry fee can also be paid by credit card (VISA or MasterCard only) or transferred directly into the Air New Zealand Holidays bank account – see Entry Form for details.

**Teams / Players:** You can enter more than one team if you have sufficient players. The entry fee will apply to each team entry.

**Individuals:** Individuals are also welcome to enter and play in a team of their choice or be allocated to a pool team. The entry fee for individual players is AU\$30.00

#### **Cancellations and Refunds of Team Entry fees:**

When unforeseen circumstances force a team to withdraw after entering a cancellation policy has been adopted for a refund. To be as fair as possible this is:

Up to 26 September 2009 - Full refund of the entry fee.

From 26 September 2009 to 26 June 2010 - 50% refund.

After 26 June 2010 - No refund.

Please note: If a team cancels yet some members still want to attend they will be welcome and can be merged with other sides.

1. The 18th Air New Zealand Golden Oldies World Rugby Festival (the 2010 Festival) is an invitation event and the Golden Oldies World Secretariat (World Secretariat) will only accept entries on this basis.
2. All players must be 35 years or older on 26 September 2010.
3. All teams travelling by air are required to travel on Air New Zealand Limited's services or other approved Star Alliance or partner carrier(s). Details will be provided as entries are received.
4. All teams must complete a form listing all team members' names and addresses (whether players or supporters) once the entry has been accepted.
5. All entries will be subject to acceptance by the World Secretariat which reserves the right to decline or withdraw any entry at any time should it consider there is non-compliance with the "Conditions of Entry. If a team is so rejected, any refund of ground package payments will only be made in accordance with the event payment schedule and refund rules applying to all teams.
6. The World Secretariat reserves the right to determine the maximum number of entries from any one country.
7. Entries will close on 30 July 2010 or at any other time at the discretion of the World Secretariat.
8. Entries will be accepted from clubs, groups or individuals who wish to form a Golden Oldies team.
9. Participants normally resident in Sydney may purchase a local package. Other teams must purchase an accommodation package.
10. Residential addresses of local team members must be supplied if requested by the Secretariat.

11. All teams must complete the official entry form, in this brochure and their appointed representative sign the Waiver, Release and Indemnification below.
12. Air New Zealand Holidays Limited reserves the right to change any venue of the 2010 Festival or any part thereof, including its removal to another country if it determines such a measure is necessary by reason of changes circumstances or conditions existing or anticipated at the 2010 Festival venue.
13. The World Secretariat collects participants' personal information in order to conduct the event. If the information requested is not provided the participant may not participate in the event.
